Sir/Madam,

- To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan College of Ayurveda, Hospital & Research Centre, Hoshangabad Road, Jatkhedhi, Bhopal-26, NH-12 Behind Vrindavan Garden, Bhopal-462047, Madhya Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0628)** inspection was conducted on **15.04.2025 and 16.04.2025 on hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the permission with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.**
- The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-**

**1. Teaching staffs:-**

a) Availability of total teaching staff for issuance of conditional permission in UG (BAMS) course after considering the visitor observation is  $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{35}{45} \times 100\% = 77.77\%$  (Excluding Excess ) Report.

10) The aforementioned shortcomings and following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 55 (2) of MESAR 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2025 to be considered for the permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-

- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
  - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
  - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
  - iv) The shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 4 above, shall be fulfilled.
- 11) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine.
